

DATA PRIVACY POLICY

Introduction

As part of its activity, TACYLATE, headquartered at 40 rue de Nangis - 77370 Clos Fontaine - France, collects and processes information, some of which is referred to as "personal data". TACYLATE attaches great importance to privacy, and uses this data only responsibly and confidentially and for a purpose. This policy details what we do with your personal information.

Personal data

The following types of personal information can be collected, stored and used on our website:

Information about your computer, including your IP address, location, type and version of your browser, and your operating system;

Information about your visits and your use of this website including the reference source, duration of the visit, page views, and website browsing paths;

Information such as your email address, which you provide us when you register on the site

Information you enter when you use the services of our website;

Information generated when using our site, including when, how often and under what circumstances you use it;

Information about the purchases you make, the services you use or the transactions you make on our website, which includes your name, address, phone number, email address and banking information;

Information contained in all communications you send us via email or on our website, including their content and metadata;

Any other personal information you give us.

Use of data

This data will be processed in our sales department. The data you give us directly are used to contact you again as part of your request.

"Web Analytics" data are collected anonymously (by registering anonymous IP addresses) by Google Analytics, and allows us to measure our website's audience, visits and possible errors to continuously improve the user experience.

Disclosure of your personal information

We may disclose your personal information to any of our employees, officers, insurers, professional advisors, agents, suppliers, or subcontractors to the extent reasonably necessary for the purposes set out in this policy:

In the execution of a supplier service (e.g. delivery)

In any ongoing or future legal proceedings;

To establish, exercise or defend our legal rights (including providing information to others for fraud prevention and credit risk reduction);

To the buyer (or potential buyer) of any business or asset in our possession that we wish (or intend to) sell; And

To any person whom we reasonably believe to be an integral part of a court or other authority responsible for the disclosure of this personal information if, in our opinion, such a court or authority would be likely to request the disclosure of this personal information.

Security of your personal information

We will take reasonable technical and organizational precautions to prevent the loss, abuse or alteration of your personal information.

We will store all the personal information you provide us on secure servers (password-protected and firewall)."

All electronic financial transactions made through our website will be protected by encryption technologies.

You recognize that the transmission of information over the internet is inherently unsecured, and that we cannot guarantee the security of your data sent over the internet.

You are responsible for the confidentiality of the password you use to access our website; we will not ask for your password (except when you identify yourself on our website).

Preservation time

Your information will be kept for a period of 3 years.

Your rights to personal data

You will keep a say in your information. You will be able to access them, correct them, request their modification and deletion and exercise your right to limit treatment. You will be able to exercise these rights at any time. To do this, you can contact our delegate:
